Ohio Law ORC 3313.67 states that all kindergarten students must have documentation of the following vaccines: 5 DPT, 4 Polio, 3 Hepatitis B, 2 MMR, and 2 Varicella.

If you have questions please contact the school nurse at 585-5981, the Logan County Health Dept at 599-9040, the Shelby County health Dept at 498-7249 or your private physician. **Those students not providing proof of immunization to the school office by October 12, 2013, will be excluded until they are in compliance.**

An audit of all kindergarten records has been completed and it has been noted that your child has not received all of the required vaccines for school attendance. Your child's record indicates that he/she needs the following:

DPT # 1, # 2, # 3, # 4, # 5

Polio # 1 #2 # 3 # 4

Hepatitis B # 1 # 2 # 3

Varicella (chickenpox) # 1 # 2
